



## JOB OPPORTUNITY: FIELD TECHNICIAN

**POSITION SUMMARY:** The Field Technician is an entry level position that assists the field crews with mountain-based work, and scientific crews with field data collection and entry. This is a full-time position for the 2023 exploration season, approximately May to October.

### KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist Mountain Crew with the construction of drill pads, waterline support, trails, brushing and clearing.
- Assist Mountain or scientific crews with field survey support.
- Provide support to consultants or Environmental with monitoring, instrument checks, weather station, data logging, and spreadsheets.
- Other duties as assigned.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- High-school diploma required; advanced education is a plus.
- No experience necessary; on the job training provided.

### KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- Ability to repetitively lift and carry up to 50 pounds and perform physically demanding work in a variety of weather conditions.
- This is a highly physical job, in varied and sometimes demanding work in difficult terrain. All potential employees will be required to pass a physical assessment.
- Basic computer skills including spreadsheets and data entry a plus.
- Mechanical aptitude with carpentry, and experience with power tools is a plus.
- Previous experience working in and around helicopters is a plus.
- Self-motivation with good attention to detailed procedures and safety requirements.
- Ability to work in adverse weather and glaciated, mountainous terrain.
- Proactive and collaborative attitude, committed to working in a team environment based on respect, trust and accountability in pursuing shared goals.
- Mindset that factors personnel safety, environmental protection, and community commitment into every decision and action.
- Effective communication, organization, and collaboration skills.
- Self-motivation with good attention to detail.
- Valid driver license with clean driving record.
- All new employees must pass a background check.
- Valid standard first aid certification a plus.

**SCHEDULE:** Work hours generally begin at 7:00 AM; schedule and rotations to be discussed.
