



## **JOB OPPORTUNITY: ENVIRONMENTAL TECHNICIAN**

**POSITION SUMMARY:** The Environmental Technician will provide support for the environmental management of the Palmer Project. This includes conducting field surveys, collecting, and analyzing environmental data, preparing reports to develop and implement environmental management plans. This is a full-time position for the 2023 exploration season, approximately May to October.

### **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Collect and analyze environmental data, including water quality, soil samples, and vegetation assessments.
- Conduct environmental field surveys in support of exploration activities.
- Prepare reports on environmental monitoring results, including recommendations for mitigating potential impacts.
- Assist with the development and implementation of environmental management plans.
- Ensure compliance with relevant regulations, including environmental permits and approvals.
- Provide environmental training to project staff as needed.
- Maintain accurate records of environmental monitoring activities.
- Participate in environmental audits and reviews.
