**POSITION SUMMARY:** The Mountain Crew supports mountain-based drilling and fieldwork activities. This is a full-time position for the 2023 exploration season, approximately May to October.

### KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Construction of drill pads and waterline support.
- Trail and road layout work, brushing and clearing.
- Environmental and geotechnical field survey support.
- Other duties as assigned.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- High-school diploma required.
- 2-5 years' experience working in and around helicopters.
- First Aid certification required, WFR/EMT Certification preferred.

### KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- Mechanical aptitude with carpentry, and experience with power tools.
- Mountain hazard awareness and risk assessment.
- Ability to repeatedly lift and carry up to 50 pounds and perform physically demanding work in a variety of weather conditions.
- Ability to work in adverse weather and glaciated, mountainous terrain.
- This is a highly physical job, in varied and sometimes difficult terrain. All potential employees will be required to pass a physical assessment.
- Avalanche Safety Certification and/or High Angle Rescue Certification is a plus.
- Proactive and collaborative attitude, committed to working in a team environment based on respect, trust and accountability in pursuing shared goals.
- Mindset that factors personnel safety, environmental protection, and community commitment into every decision and action.
- Effective communication, organization, and collaboration skills.
- Self-motivation with good attention to detail.
- Valid driver license with clean driving record.
- All new employees must pass a background check.
- Valid standard first aid certification a plus.
